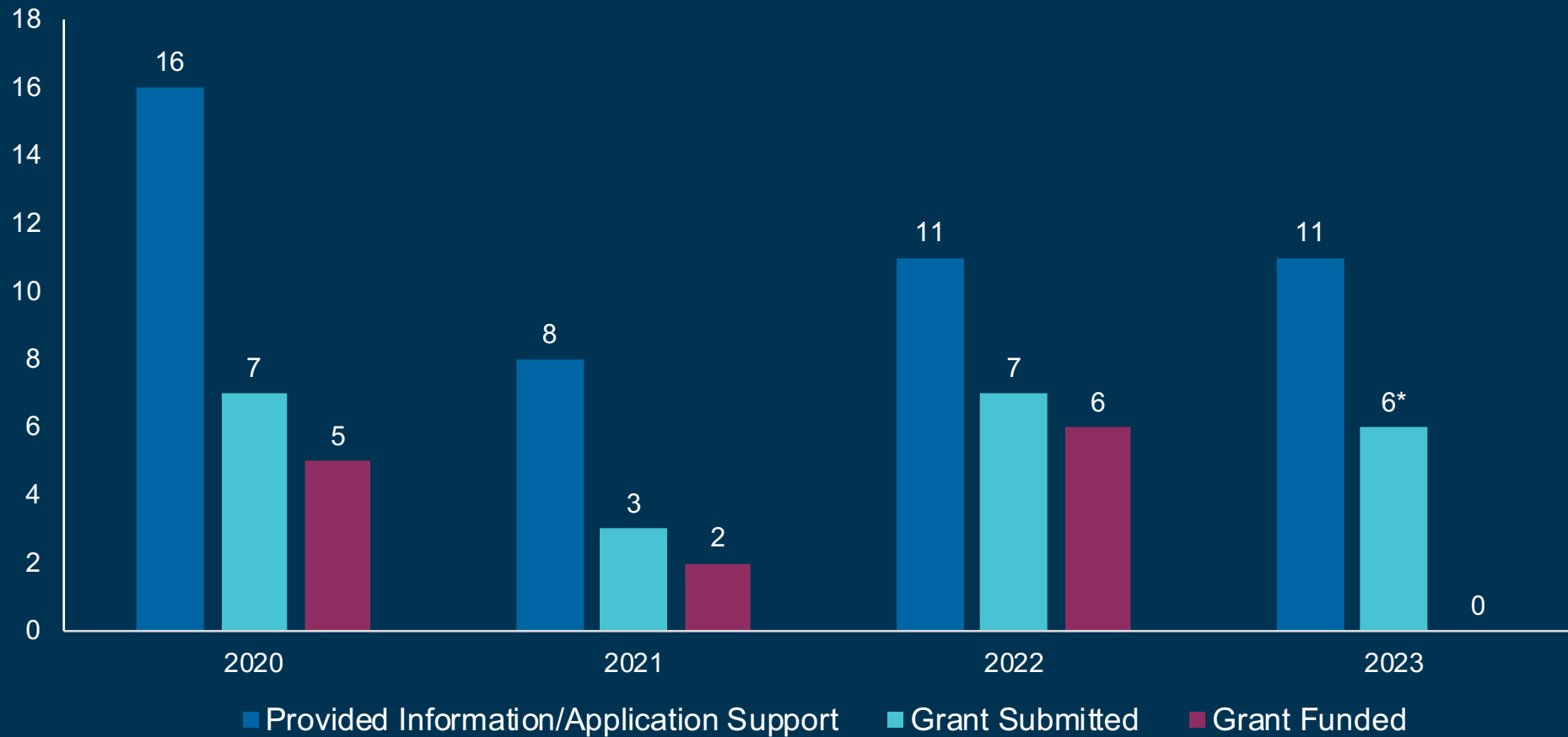

*ASAP Program (The Affiliated Scholars Advancement Program)

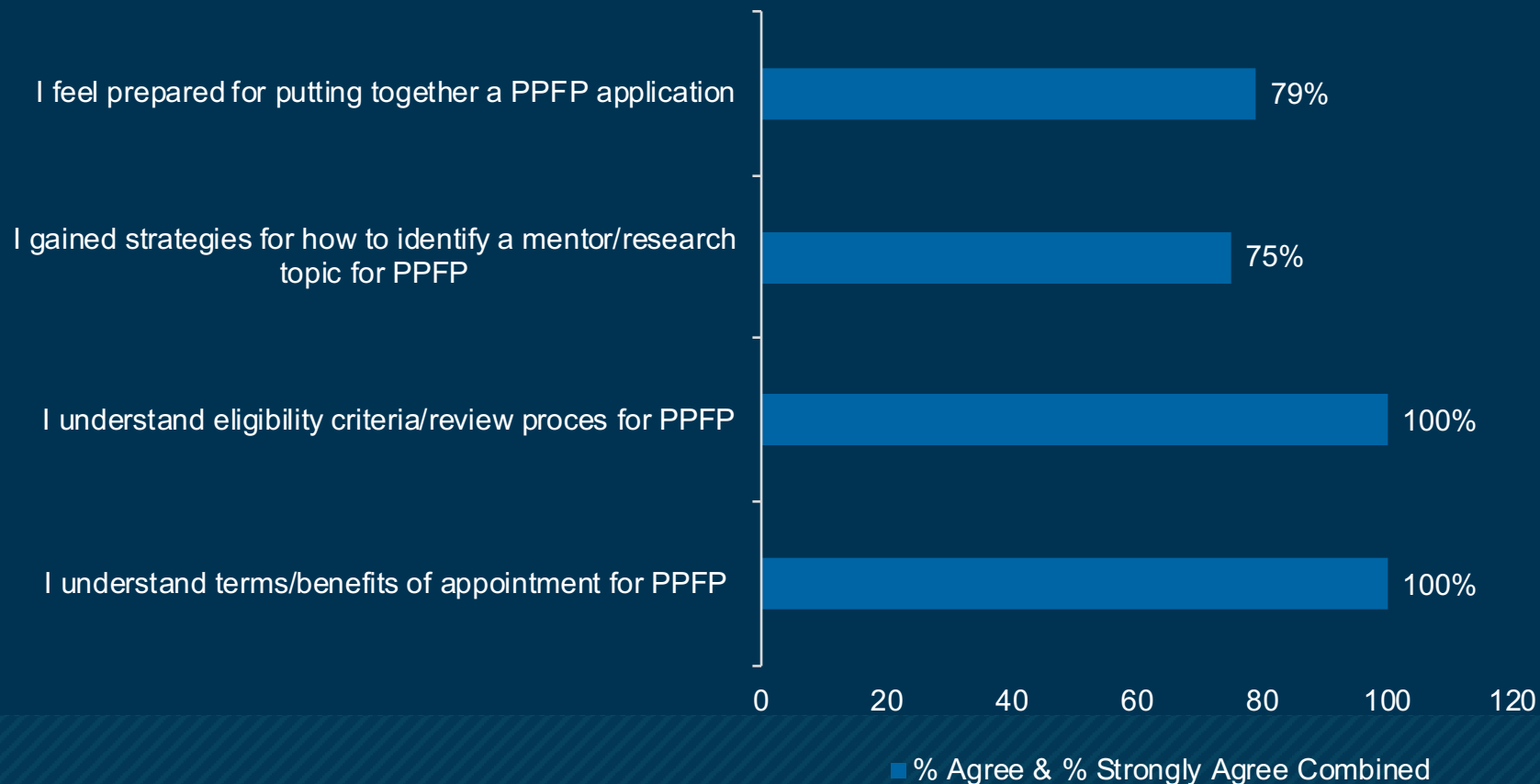
*As of 2023, 7 of 16 scholars have meet the NIH criteria for URM

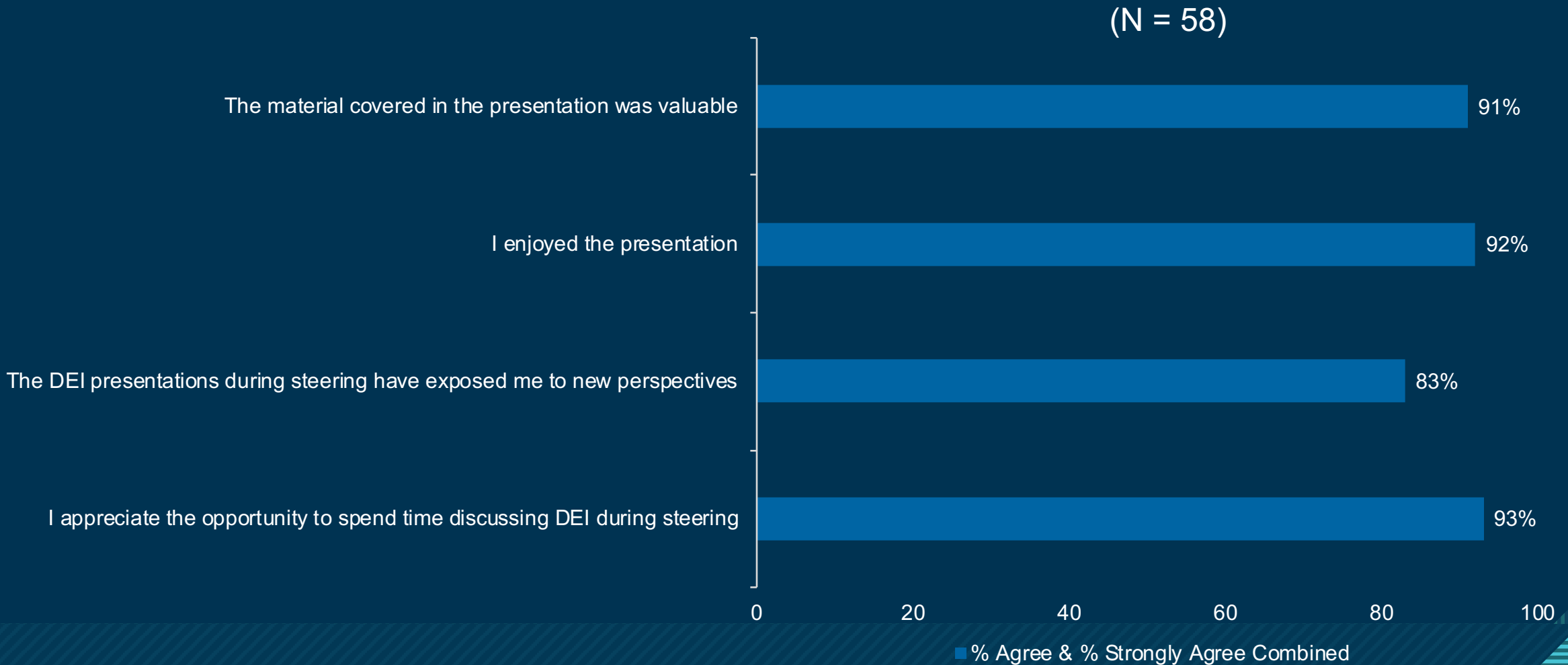
